The YWCA Canada's Uplift Program provides women and non-binary people the opportunity to enhance and acquire skills and knowledge to enter the information and cybersecurity fields through certification training with a provincially recognized educational institution and supports related to job development and pre-employment skills. Training fees for participants are covered by FedDev Ontario. The YWCA Canada Uplift staff will assist program participants to achieve better employment outcomes and navigate traditionally male-dominated workplaces.

Eligibility

- Women (cisgender or transgender) or non-binary
- Bachelor's Degree, diploma, or relevant experience
- Canadian Citizen or Permanent Resident residing in Ottawa, Peterborough, Kingston, Cornwall
- Canadian Language Benchmark levels 7-8
- Must have a background, transferable skills, or work experience in the following fields: Information Technology, Computer Science, Software Engineering, Project Management, Business Administration, Financial Management, or Human Resources
- Able to commit to a part-time 17-week synchronous training program; classes are scheduled twice per week from 9:00a.m. to 12:00p.m.
